Content

The Watch Magazine will never knowingly publish AI generated writing or images without a statement of transparency at the beginning of the article.

We strive to continue to report on The University of King's College and its students as accurately as we can, and with as many human voices as we can.

Executive members

The Watch's section editors, copyeditor and editor-in-chief are responsible for screening all submitted pieces for the use of AI generated writing. They follow the same guidelines as contributors in terms of AI usage.

Contributors

The Watch Magazine prohibits the use of artificial intelligence in contributor-submitted pieces or photos.

Exclusions can occur, and contributors are encouraged to reach out to section editors or the editor-in-chief to discuss stories in which AI generation can be used – while maintaining full transparency with readers.

The Watch Magazine reserves the right to refuse any articles, photos or other media that has been created by AI. We urge contributors to be transparent with their use of AI.
